We have an exciting opportunity for your daughter. I am the Library Media Specialist and Classroom Technology Department Chair at Mother of Mercy High School and I am also the moderator of our Tech Doctors service club. The mission of this group is to strengthen the critical thinking and technology skills of young women and to provide help in maintaining our school's technology. One of the activities of our group is to mentor grade school girls in the area of technology. For the past nine years we have been partnering with Our Lady of Lourdes, St. Catharine, and St. Martin.
